


1. Taj Mahal – Agra, Uttar Pradesh



4. Ladakh – Jammu & Kashmir (now Union Territory)




A stark yet stunning Himalayan landscape, “Little Tibet,” high-altitude lakes, monasteries—it’s adventure defined.



6. Jaipur – Rajasthan




The Pink City—Wall to wall palaces, forts, and markets. Rajasthan’s regal energy captured perfectly here.

7. Goa – Goa


Sunny beaches, Portuguese architecture, vibrant nightlife—the perfect blend of temperate relaxation and cultural vibes.

8. Khajuraho – Madhya Pradesh




World-famous for its intricate, sensuous temple carvings that tell vivid tales of love, spirituality, and art.
